

My fee for medico-legal work is as follows:

I charge for my time at **Two hundred twenty pounds (£220) per hour** for all work, including time for reading relevant documentation, examination of client, meetings conferences, telephone conversations and travelling time.

My daily rate for attending court to give expert evidence is **One thousand six hundred pounds (£1600) per day or part thereof**. I expect payment even if I do not give oral evidence.

Following **cancellation charges** will apply:

Court attendance:	4 weeks or more notice	no cancellation charge
	2-4 weeks notice	£800
	2 weeks or less	£1000
Appointment:	2 weeks or more	no cancellation charge
	2 weeks or less	£400

Any additional report, addendums, joint statements, meeting with other experts, etc. will be charged at the hourly rate of £220 per hour.

The solicitors' firm instructing me shall be liable for my fee, whether or not recovery from the client or other sources is achieved.

I expect payment within 60 days of invoice date. Thereafter, the instructor is liable for interest of 1.5% per month.

I do not work on "no win, no fee basis" as this may prejudice my independent status.
